

Camp & RV Sites at Virginia Nazarene Camp

Greetings Fellow Christians;

DIG Camp Meeting dates: June 26 – July 1, 2018.

The following procedures are in effect for the Virginia District Campground campsites;

1. Reservations will open up April 2 2018. This year you will again need to contact me to reserve your site. My preference in contacting is by e-mail at holterjr@comcast.net. Alternately, you can call me at 540-830-9099, be advised that I work so if calling, you probably will have to leave a message and I will call you back. If you call please leave your name, phone number, and if you have texting capability (this will allow me to check your availability prior to calling). The reservation fee for 2018 is \$50.00.
2. Site assignment are made predominately by first come, first served with due consideration given to the length of your camper. You can indicate your preference for Lakeside or Gaddy if you desire but please understand that I cannot promise specific locations. The reservation fee is \$50.00 which must be paid at the time of registration. In the event that you cannot use the campsite requested for DIG Camp Meeting, the fee can only be refunded if you let me know two weeks in advance.
3. Please register your party and pay for your site as soon after your arrival as possible. I will have registration forms at my Cabin #126 {White with screened in porch across from the prophet's house}. The forms will be passed to the office expeditiously to enable them to contact you should the need arise. The parking and hookup fee is \$25.00 for RVs and \$10.00 for pop-up and tents. I will be arriving at the campground June 26th 2017 for registration and assistance.
4. This year, again, there will be a "Porta John" located close to the tent area which is adjacent to Gaddy RV sites.
5. The Camp Pet Policy is officially in effect. If you are planning to bring a pet, please read over the policy and print out Camp Pet Release Form and also attach the copy of the vaccination record to the form prior to turning it in to me when registering.

Reminder:

Please be sure all of your equipment is in good operating condition. You or the person you are borrowing your equipment from should check out the equipment before you come to camp. Things can happen when camping equipment sits unused for even just a few weeks. You can't be sure if you don't check and it is obviously better to find out about problems before you get to camp.
